- 1. Call to Order:** Mr. Brown began the meeting at 7 PM.
- 2. Roll Call:** There was a roll call of Council Members. No police, fire or engineers reports were presented.
- 3. Public Comment:** Bob Fardo at 4 Stratford Road came to Council tonight because they currently have a water drainage issue that was not an issue prior to the curb project. What happens is, when there is a decent amount of rain, it no longer is draining along the road but cuts across their carport into their yard. Prior to the curb construction, there was no curb on Biddeford, but after 2021 there's now a curb directing the water into their yard. Mr. Fardo had conversations in the past with the engineer who stated they would put a hump in, which he states helps some, but water is still getting over the hump they put in. Ms. Rattay shared a video of this with Council members so they can show the Borough engineer to begin discussion on the next steps. Mr. Stiller added that there's still an outstanding punch list, so this may be added to the list. Mr. Dismukes added that the bus stop on Oxford needs some adjusting as well as one of the poles have come out of the road. Mr Fardo will send the video to the Borough and the Streets/Sewer Committee will engage with the engineer on a possible remedy.
- 4. Table Agenda Items:** *A motion was made by Mr. Stiller to table the following items for next month's meeting: Approval of the March 2022 minutes, February 2022 Financials, Greenspace update which includes the park maintenance and leaf pickup contracts, Insurance policy and Action items. Mrs. Neunder seconds the motion. Motion passed unanimously.*
- 5. Approve Agenda Items:** *A motion was made by Mrs. Neunder to approve the following items: Resolution 2022-02, Resolution 2022-03, Ordinance 279, Donation for the July 4th fireworks for \$250.00. Mr. Stiller seconds the motion. Motion passed unanimously.*
