

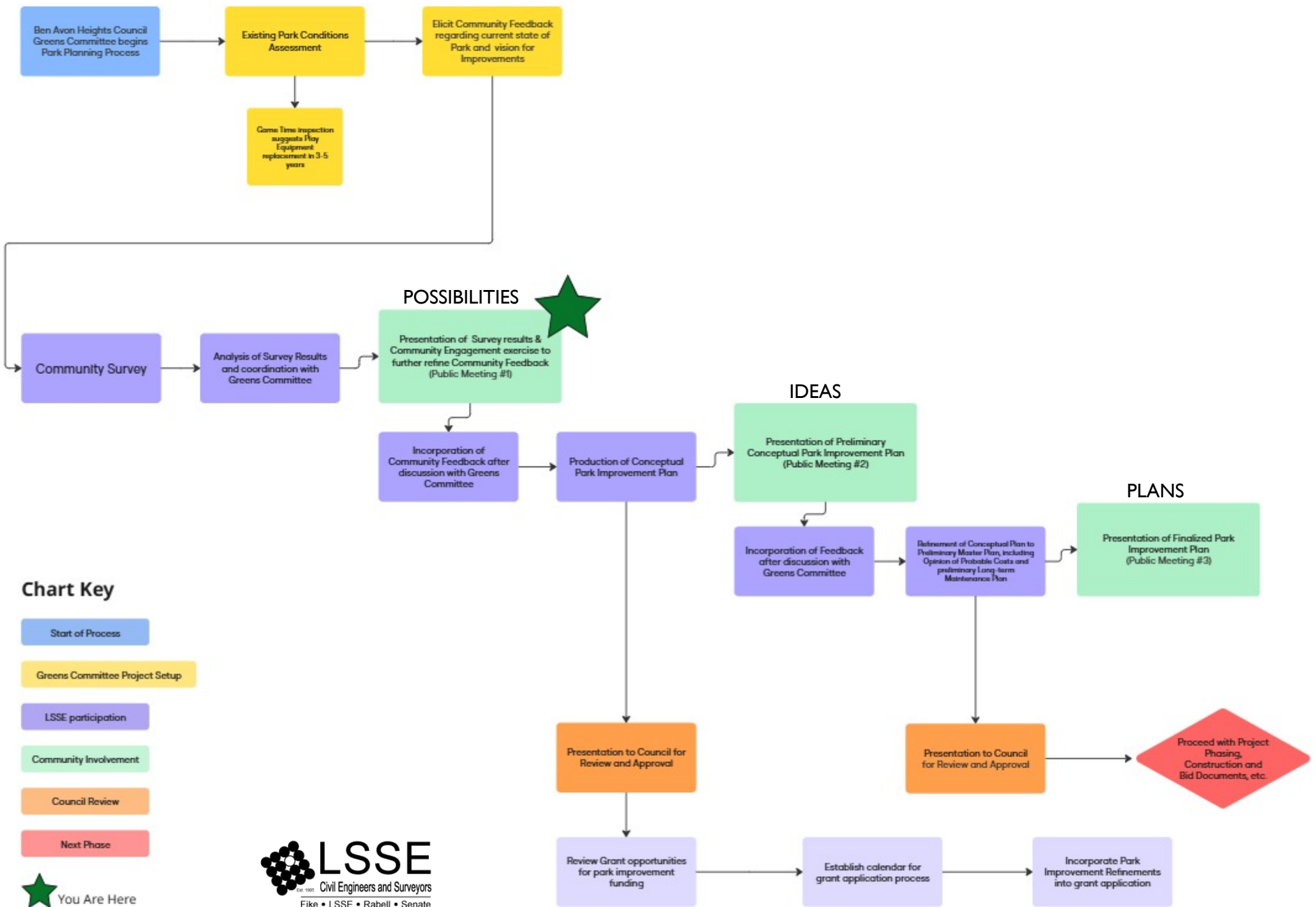
POSSIBILITIES

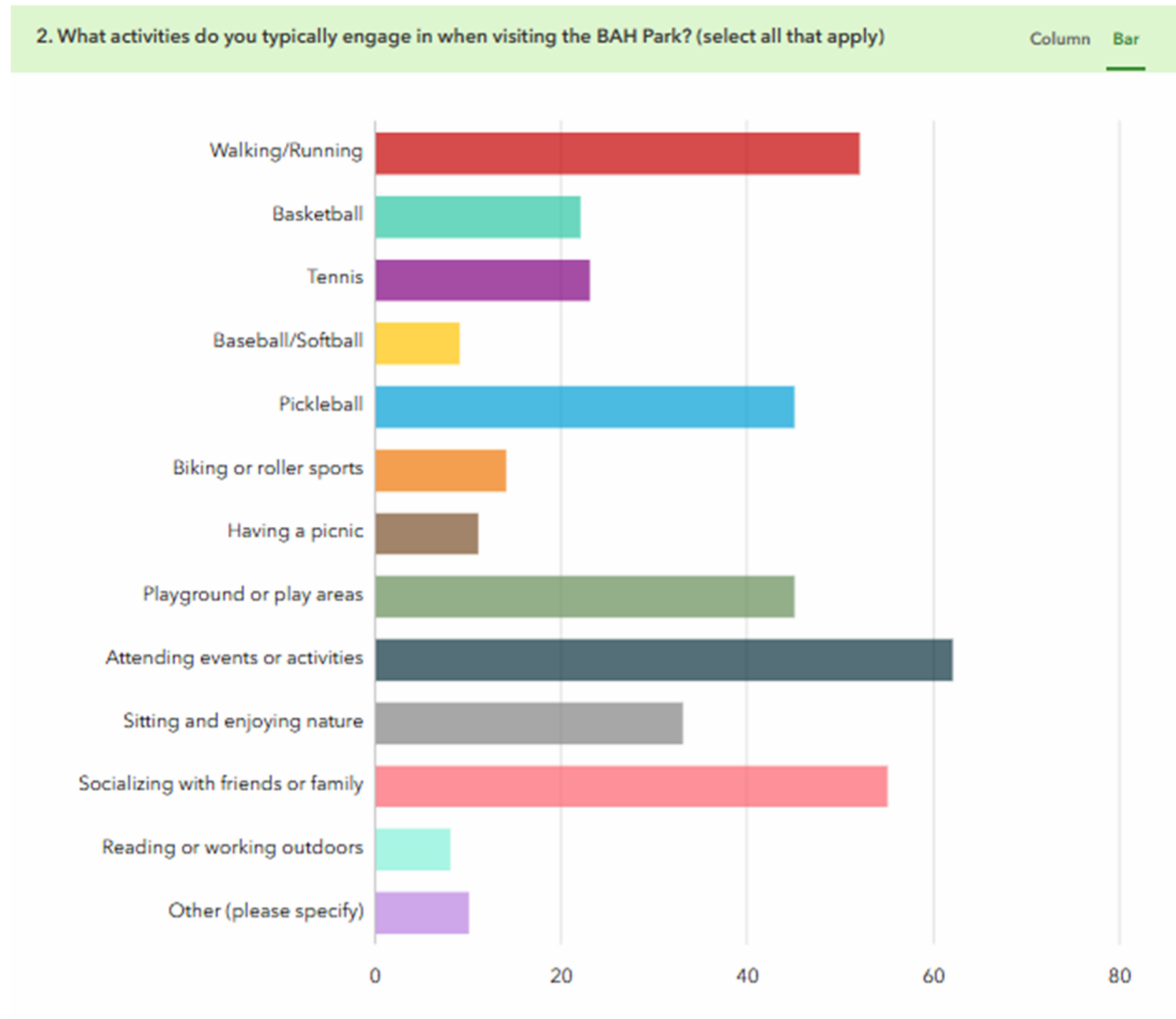

Ben Avon Heights Park Beautification Project - Process Flowchart



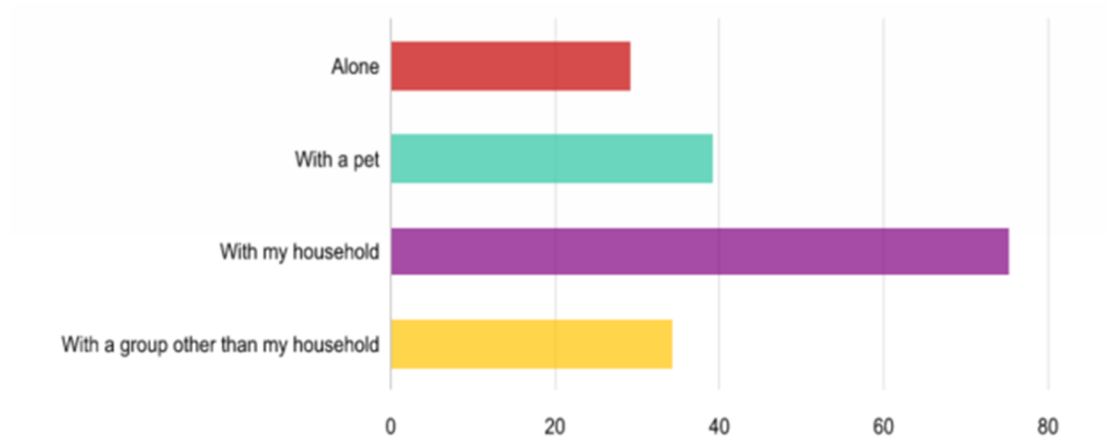
Survey Background/Purpose:

The Borough of Ben Avon Heights conducted a community survey to gather input on planned upgrades to Ben Avon Heights Park. Residents shared their priorities, ideas, and feedback to help shape future improvements, including recreational amenities, accessibility, and overall park experience. The responses provided valuable insights that will guide the enhancement of the park to better serve the community. The survey was open February 20 through March 5, 2025. A total of 104 surveys were submitted.

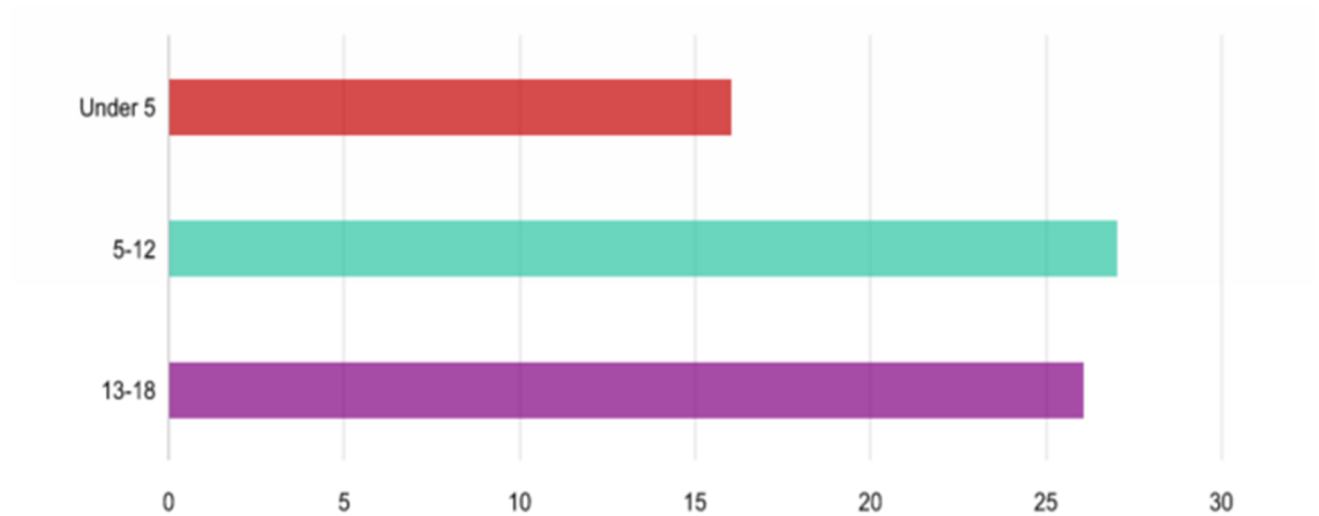

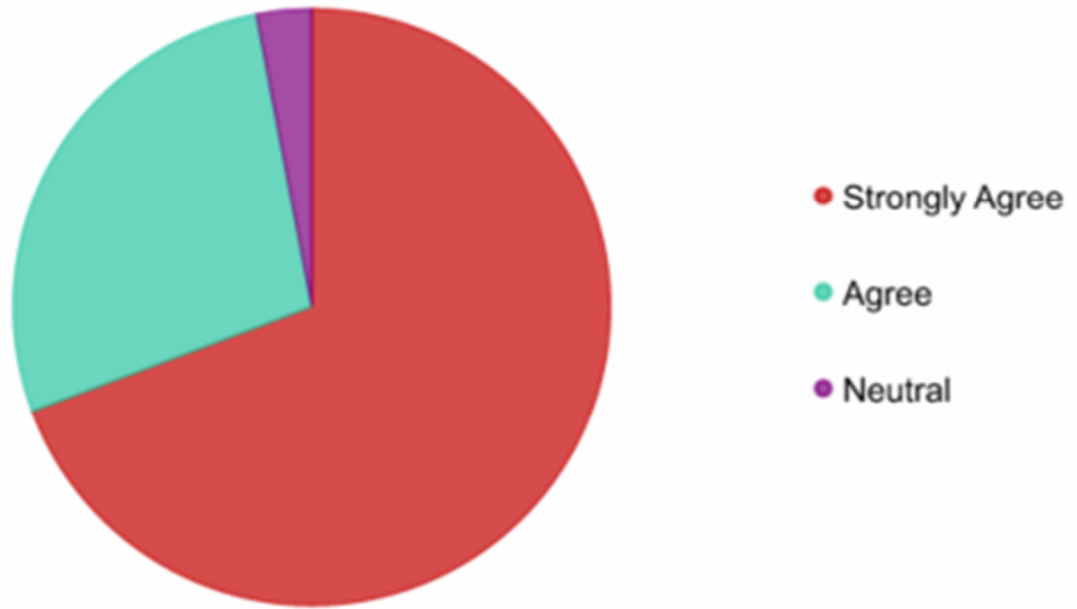


If you have children under 18, what are their ages?

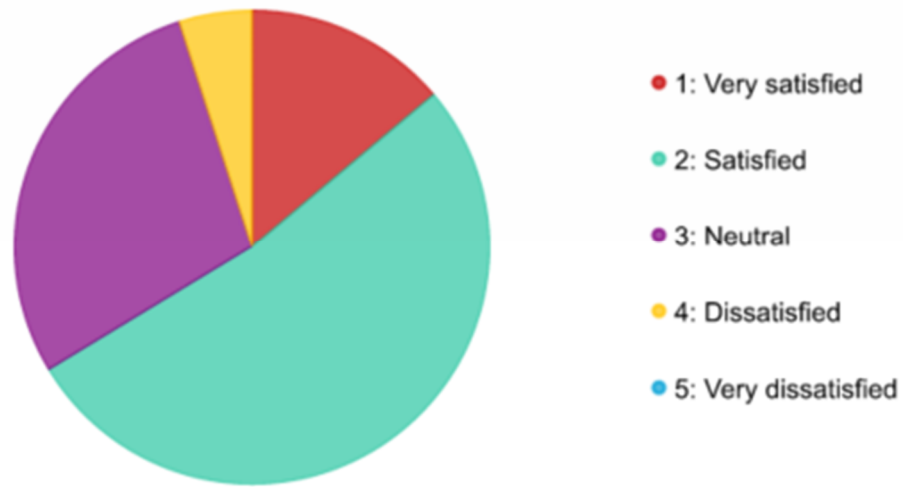

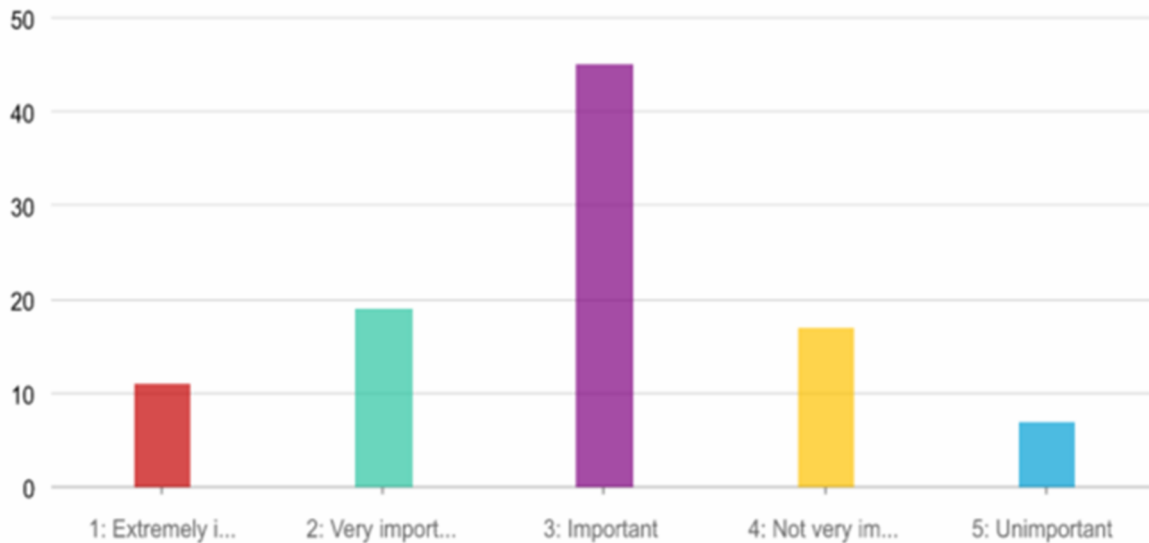
How satisfied are you with the current state of the park?
